- Our standard annual fee includes: Certificate of Registration, Certificate of Airworthiness, Noise Certificate, Aircraft Radio Station License, Mode S code designation, out-of-sequence registration marks, AFM approval, Minor and Major Mods approvals, Airspace approvals (RVSM, MNPS, etc.), AWOPS, initial manuals review and approval for (MEL, MP, MCM, etc.)
- Cape Town Convention Contracting State
- Favorable tax jurisdiction- 0% VAT, 0% Corporation Tax, 0% Income Tax, no import tax, and more...
