It is now DCA Aruba policy that the Certificate of Registration is issued for a period of maximum 3 years or until the expiration date of the applicable lease or management agreement, whichever occurs first.

If the lease or management agreement expiration date is close to the expiration date of the Certificate of Registration it is advisable for the operator to renew the lease or management agreement before renewing the Certificate of Registration.
